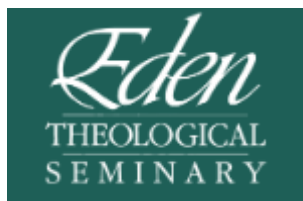

Course Code and Title	<b>ST2003: Social Enterprise</b>
Course Description	This course introduces students to the field of Social Entrepreneurship; the practice of identifying, designing, starting and growing successful mission-driven ventures. The course provides an applied understanding of the processes, challenges and demands associated with creating ventures that seek to integrate financial and social/environmental benchmarks of success. Students will design a real world social transformation project, related to their capstone issue that is scalable and sustainable in today's economic and social realities. Entrepreneurship in general, and Social Entrepreneurship in particular, is a participatory sport. It is not something that can be learned simply from reading and lectures. This course will be no different. Each week's session will require your active participation and engagement, both during the class period and in active discussion forums throughout the week.

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<b>Course Code and Title</b>	<b>HT770: Ecclesiology: Church and the World</b>
Course Description	This DMin seminar explores the idea of "church" and its engagements with the public spheres. It begins with a brief historical survey of ecclesiology, examining not only the Nicene marks of the church and bringing them into conversation with discourses on justice and witness. It then engages with the different ways in which church relates with the world, and imagine possibilities and strategies for church to engage with present challenges in the world.
